DISCOVER NEW PROSPECTS IN THE GOLDEN TRIANGLE

A rise in commodity prices and improvements in infrastructure have made the Golden Triangle one of the hottest mineral exploration districts in the world.

THE GOLDEN TRIANGLE

The Golden Triangle area in northwest BC has been a focus of mineral exploration and mining activity for over 150 years. Early discoveries included significant gold, silver, copper, zinc, lead and molybdenum deposits throughout the region, which covers nearly one-quarter of the province.

- ▶ **“Modern day gold rush”** supported by:
 - Higher gold prices, the discovery of high-grade deposits and two new mines: Red Chris and Brucejack.
 - New infrastructure including highway upgrades, ocean port facilities and a \$700M transmission line.
 - Meaningful Indigenous partnerships.
- ▶ **\$163.8M exploration expenditure in 2018**, up 66% from 2017 and almost double 2016.
- ▶ **Companies in the region:** GT Gold, Skeena, Dolly Varden Silver, Ascot, Kutcho Copper, Seabridge Gold, Teck, Imperial Metals, Copper Fox, Newmont and Pretivm.
- ▶ There are projects in the region that have Environmental Assessment certificates but require investment to advance to production.
