Application for a Permit Under The Provisions of the Environmental Management Act

We, Ascot Resources Ltd., 1050 – 1095 West Pender Street, Vancouver, BC, V6E 3S7, intend to submit this

application to the Director to authorize the construction of a sewage treatment plant, and the discharge of waste

effluent from a gold mine. The new sewage treatment plant will be constructed to treat sewage waste from the mill

building, administration offices, mine dry, truck shop, maintenance shop, the assay lab and cold storage, and

underground via a pumpr truck.

The land upon which the facility is situated and the discharge will occur is the Premier Gold Mine, located

approximately 25 kilometres (km) north of Stewart, BC, within the Salmon River watershed, in the Kitimat Stikine

Regional District. The Premier Gold Mine is located within the Nass Area, Nisga'a Lands, and within the Aboriginal

Interest Area of the Tsetsaut/Skii Km Lax Ha.

The maximum rate of treated sewage effluent discharged to the Tailings Storage Facility is 40 m³/day or 0.5 L/s. The

treated sewage effluent will be combined with the thickened tailings slurry line for deposition in the Tailings Storage

Facility. Reclaim water pulled from the Tailings Storage Facility supernatant pond will be used in the mill as process

water only. The Tailings Storage Facility discharge will be first directed to and treated by the Moving Bed Biofilm

Reactor (MBBR) system, then it is directed to and treated by the High-Density Sludge Water Treatment Plant. The

maximum rate of discharge from the Water Treatment Plant to Cascade Creek at S-13A is 22,000 m³/day. The
